1. Click the Mail icon in the application bar

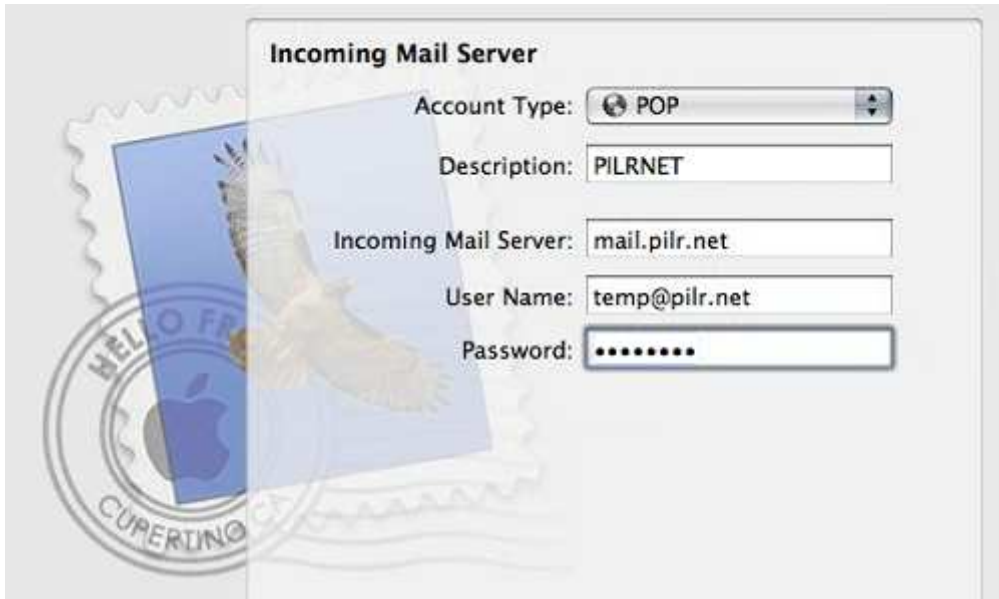


Or click on your Macintosh hard drive, click Applications, then find Mail in the list.

2. A new account wizard will come up. Type in your Full Name, Email Address, and Password and click Continue.

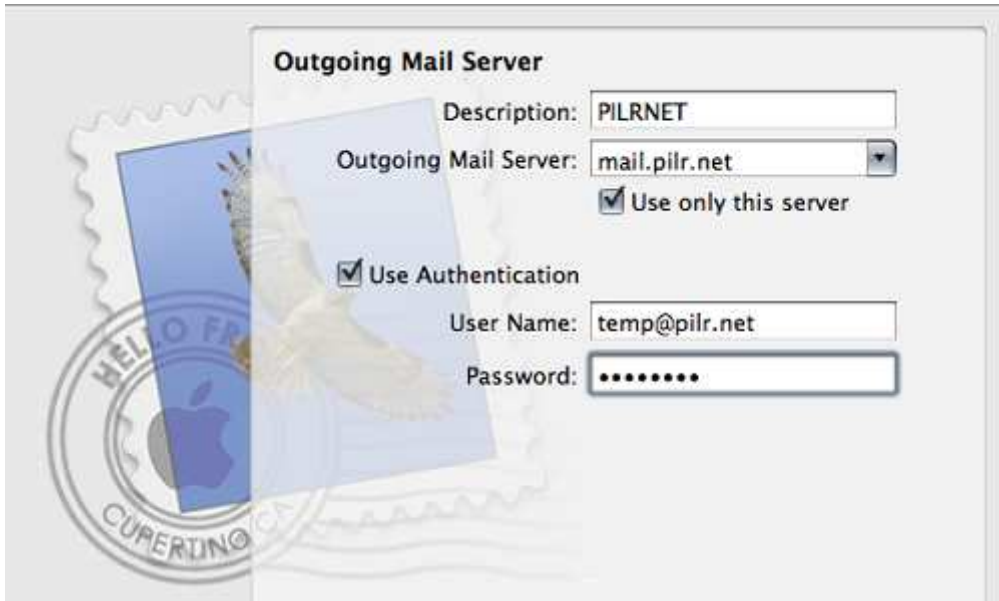
3. Under Account Type Select POP. Fill in the wanted Description. Type the incoming server with the one provided to you (example mail.pilr.net) and the User Name will be your full email address. Enter the Password and click Continue.



4. Check the box that says “Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)” and make sure the Authentication says Password and click Continue.



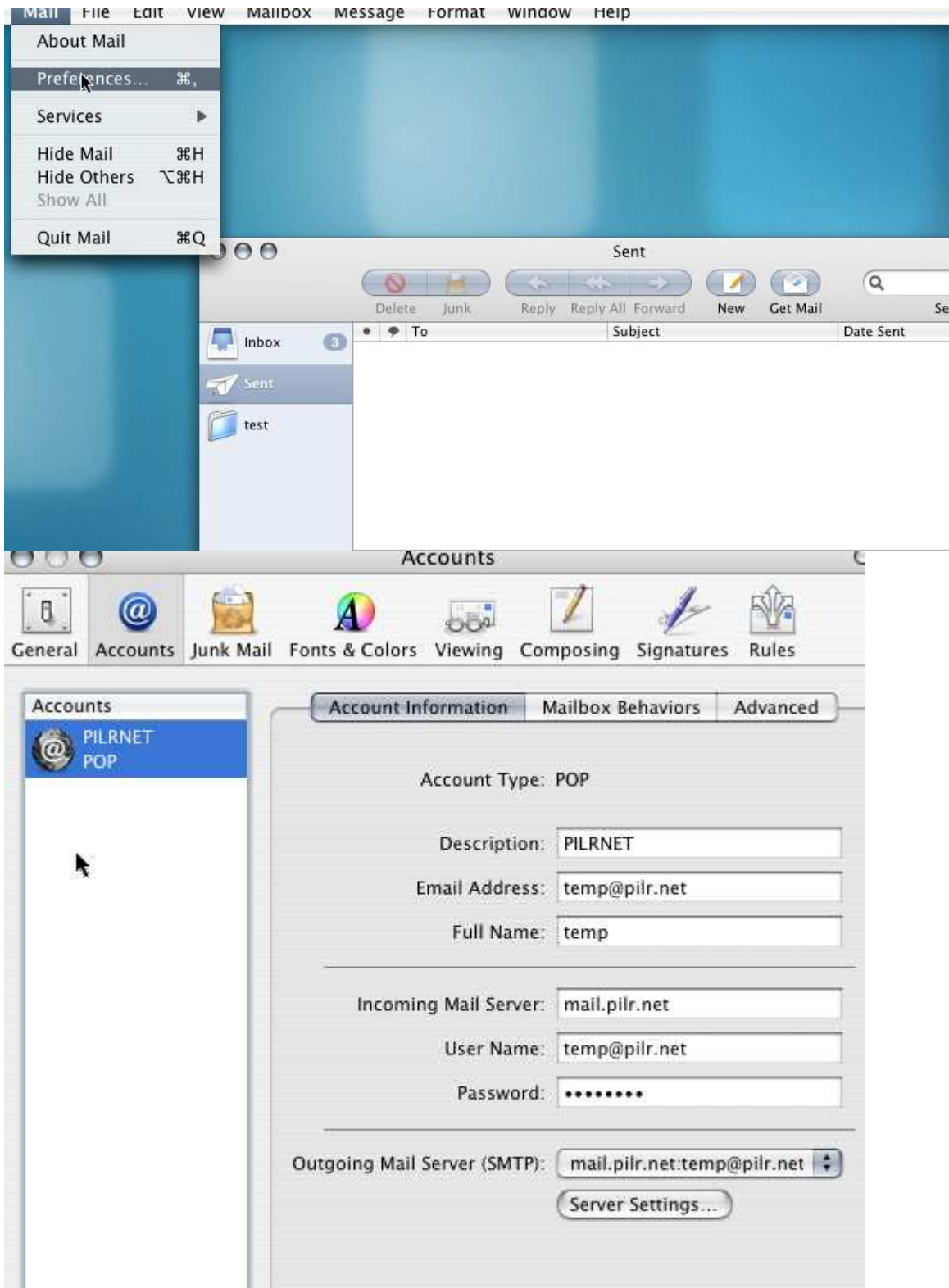
5. Enter a description and the Outgoing Mail Server provided to you (example mail.pilr.net). Check the box that says “Use only this server” and check the box that says “Use Authentication” and enter your User Name which will be your full E-mail address and your password and click Continue.



6. The following screen will come up with the information entered. Click Create.

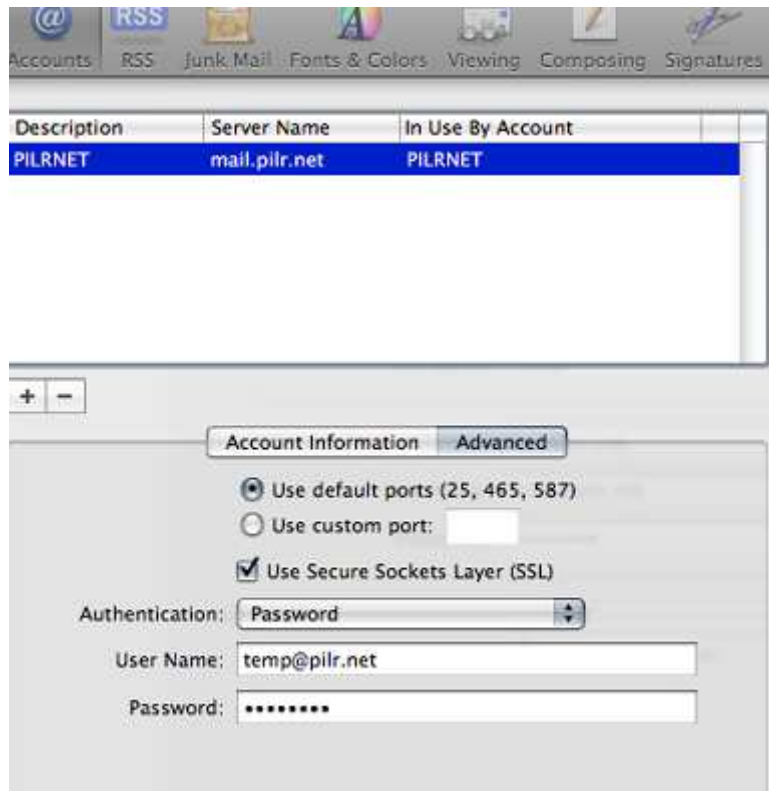


7. Click Mail>Preferences>Accounts.

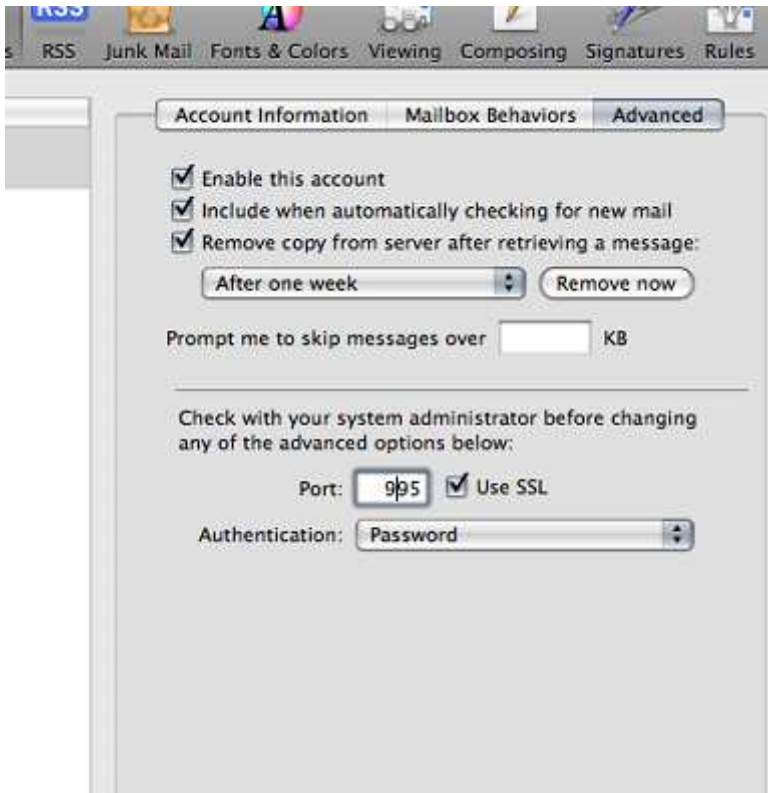


8. On the line Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP) click the arrows and select Edit Server List. Click the Advanced Tab. Check the checkbox that says “Use

Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)” and select Password as the Authentication Type and click OK.



9. Click on the Advanced tab and change the Port number from 110 to 995. Click the arrows and select Password for Authentication.



10. Click the X in the upper left corner of the screen.



11. When asked to save click Save.



12. You may now receive your mail.
